# Seminar on Capturing Carbon Market and Carbon Credit Trading Development Opportunities



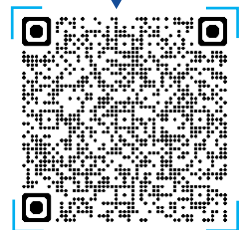
